### Introduction

This Privacy Policy outlines how Personal information is collected, used, and shared when you visit or interact with our website (the "Site").

- **Log Files:** Track actions on the Site and collect data such as your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.
- Web Beacons, Tags, and Pixels: Electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

#### **How We Use Your Personal Information**

We use the information collected to:

- Communicate with you.
- Screen for potential risk or fraud.
- Provide information or advertising based on your preferences.
- Improve and optimize the Site through analytics.

# **Sharing Your Personal Information**

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use it as described above. Examples include:

We may also share your Personal Information to comply with legal obligations or protect our rights.
